



Legal dependents of ordained Southern Baptist ministers employed by a Southern Baptist Church or legal dependents of ordained ministers of a New Testament church outside the Southern Baptist denomination are eligible to apply for the Minister's Appreciation Grant in addition to other merit-based scholarships. This grant is not stackable with talent-based aid and amounts vary based on need. This grant may be awarded for a maximum of eight semesters; however, maximum aggregate eligibility will be pro-rated for entering transfer students and upperclassmen receiving this award for the first time (for example, a second semester sophomore who receives the scholarship for the first time will be eligible for a maximum of five semesters).

****Definition of Legal Dependent for Minister's Dependent Grant:*** A legal dependent is defined, for the purposes of this grant, as a person who is claimed by the ordained minister employed by a Southern Baptist/New Testament church on his federal income tax return and/or by the results of the FAFSA. If a student who is claimed as a dependent of a minister marries while attending the University of Mobile, he/she is no longer eligible to receive the Minister's Dependent Grant.
