

## A. UNIFORMS

### Requirements:

Students should purchase **at least:**

- 2 uniform tops (monogrammed)
- 2 uniform pants
- 1 lab coat (monogrammed)

**\*Descriptions and item numbers are listed below**

Upon receipt of your acceptance letter into the BSN program, students should contact Uniforms by Bayou regarding uniform fittings and purchases. Uniform tops and lab coat must be monogrammed with the UM logo by Uniforms by Bayou. **Please note, it takes at least 2-3 weeks for uniform monogramming, so plan accordingly with this time frame in mind.**

**Students will be expected to be in uniform and have all required supplies by the first day of class.**

### Uniforms:

Female Classroom and Clinical Uniform Top: Female Black top (item# 2801 or 2802)  
Classroom and Clinical Uniform Pant: Female Black pant (item# 6801 or 6802)

Male Classroom and Clinical Uniform Top: Male Black top (item# 2851)  
Classroom and Clinical Uniform Pant: Male Black pant (item# 6851)

### Lab Coat:

A full-length lab coat (embroidered with UM logo) is required for all students.  
(Item# 3155 or 3166)

### Outer Wear:

Outerwear is permitted in the classroom; however, it is limited to a black or white jacket. Uniforms by Bayou has a black jacket that matches your uniform that you may purchase and have monogrammed; **however, this jacket is not mandatory.** The store may tell you that it is, but it is not!

## B. SHOES

- Shoes may be purchased at a retailer of your choice
- Uniforms by Bayou has nursing shoes in stock
- Shoes must be SOLID black (preferably leather)
- Clogs or shoes with mesh inserts **are not allowed** (these types of shoes are permeable and will allow bodily fluids to soak through the shoe)
- Attached to this packet are some examples of what is or is not allowed
- If you are unsure if your shoes will work, you may email Mrs. Brown a picture so that she can look at them

## C. SUPPLIES

### Required medical supplies:

- **Stethoscope**
- **Pen light**
- **Bandage Scissors**
- **Manual blood pressure cuff**
- **Watch with a second hand:** The band of the watch should be leather, silicone, or other similar material that may be wiped clean with a disinfectant. **Apple Watches ARE NO LONGER permissible!** It is recommend you purchase an inexpensive watch with a second-hand that you don't mind getting wet or dirty.

### Optional supplies:

- Clipboard with storage compartment
- Hemostats

\*Each student will receive a skills bag the first week of class that will include all supplies that are required for skills lab practice during the first course (NU309). Included in this bag will also be a **pen light, bandage scissors, and a manual blood pressure cuff.** \*

\*\* All other supplies may be purchased at Uniforms by Bayou, the University of Mobile bookstore, or a medical-supply company of your choice. \*\*

## D. BADGE CLIP & STUDENT NURSE BADGE

Each student is required to purchase one University of Mobile badge clip (that includes a plastic holder and a "student nurse" badge) as an additional requirement of the uniform, at a cost of \$10.00 (cash only) total. The badge clip will be used to affix the name tag to the uniform. Additional clips may be purchased at the same time or throughout the program (at the same

cost). Students who break or damage their badge clip will be required to replace it at their expense throughout the program.

Badge clips may be purchased any time, Monday – Thursday, 8:00am – 4:00pm, on campus. They are available in the College of Health Professions, Weaver Hall, Suite 316, at the front desk. If you are unable to purchase your badge prior to start of the semester, badges will be available for purchase on the first day of class during orientation.

All “student nurse” identification cards will be made the first week of class. We will go as a group to get these made. Please do not attempt to do this in advance of the first week of class.

**\*\*The “student nurse” ID is NOT the same as your “student” ID.** Please make sure that you have obtained your *student ID* prior to the beginning of classes. \*\*
